A strong academic and integrated curriculum provides opportunities for children to learn and hone their skills in: math exploration and computation, phonics and reading, whole language and writer's workshop, science discoveries, writing journals as well as social studies topics that extend into the child's environment.

Conflict Resolution through Literature will be taught by using a Literature based Values Curriculum that will help children learn to make good choices, solve problems and reinforce Christian values taught at home and at school.

Cultural studies include Australia, Pilgrims and Colonial Life, Native Americans, Africa, China, Mexico, Black History, Great Americans, Immigration and Women's History.

Theme units are integrated into the regular curriculum and include: Myself, My Family, My Home, Dinosaurs, Bugs, and the Earth and Our Environment. Children study Matter, Mass, Volume, Gravity, Solids and Liquids, Electricity, Inventions and learn by doing experiments and activities.

Children learn to be independent learners, readers and writers. Everyday station activities and reading groups promote strong, fluent readers and writers.

The Bible studies will require children to put God's teaching into practice in their everyday life.
